- (1) why you should be selected as a recipient for this scholarship (Please include your current advocacy accomplishments)
- (2) a unique way you could encourage PT/PTA colleagues or patients in advocacy related to the physical therapy profession
- (3) how this scholarship will help advance you in the neurologic physical therapy profession. Highlight your passion, commitment, and creativity!

Award Notification & Duties: ACA Committee will review applications and select the recipient by March, 15. The winner will be notified by March 18, 2024. One scholarship will be awarded. Recipient will self-register for PT on Capitol Hill Day and make their own travel arrangements. Recipient will have opportunities to mentor and network with ACA committee members prior to and during PT on Capitol Hill Day After the Forum, recipient will submit receipts to ANPT for reimbursement of allowable expenses up to \$1000. Recipient will also share about their advocacy experience on Capitol Hill in the ANPT Newsletter, and by engaging with other students through social media from programs that will be selected by the ACA Committee.
