There are eight special interest groups within ANPT which include Assistive Technology/Seating & Wheeled Mobility, Balance and Falls, Brain Injury, Degenerative Diseases, Residency & Fellowship, Spinal Cord Injury, Stroke and Vestibular Rehabilitation. These special interest groups provide a forum to discuss advances in practice and the challenges of patient care within these specialty areas.

Special Interest Group Logo Use Policy

Special Interest Groups that have a logo for their group or for an event created need to have the Executive Office Marketing Communications Manager and Board of Directors approval prior to use.

Event Logo Criteria:

- 1. Use a tagline to show this event is part of the ANPT. Suggested verbiage is Supported by the Academy of Neurologic Physical Therapy
- Tagline should be no smaller than
 pts smaller then smallest font on logo
- 3. Incorporating the color scheme of ANPT is required
- 4. Logo can have multiple versions to best format into materials.

SIG Logo Criteria:

- 1. The name of the Special Interest Group should be spelled out
- 2. Academy of Neurologic Physical Therapy needs to be spelled out

APTA Relationship

The Academy of Neurologic Physical Therapy (ANPT) is a suborganization called a component of the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA). ANPT like most components are a separately incorporated nonprofit organization governed by the Board of Directors and separate by-laws. Components have committees and special interest groups within their organizations as well as paid staff to manage the component.

To be a member of a component requires membership in the APTA and a state component. All membership management is managed by the APTA through their website www.apta.org or memberservices@apta.org.

Governance

APTA Board of Directors

The Board of Directors comprises 15 members: 6 officers and 9 directors. Members of the Board, appointed through a nominations and elections process, assume office at the close of the House of Delegates at which they were elected. A complete term for a Board member is 3 years.

House of Delegates

The House of Delegates (House) is an APTA policy-making body comprised of voting chapter delegates, non-voting delegates (the Board of Directors and section, assembly, and PTA Caucus delegates), and consultants.

The House meets annually for 3 successive days each spring, during which time delegates make decisions on issues that may have far-reaching implications for the association and the profession of physical therapy. More information may be found at http://www.apta.org/HOD/

- Headlines should be brief. No more than 2 lines long preferable 1 line. Use Heading 2 as a subhead for more detail if needed.
- Headlines: H1
 - o Do not use colons afterward
 - o Do not underline
- Subhead: H2 or H3
 - o Do not use colons afterward
 - o Do not underline
 - Use H3 if needed for a header below a subhead
- Body Copy: Paragraph
 - o Paragraphs justified left
 - Lists use solid black bullets
 - Black font (links will turn orange which is okay)
- Spacing
 - If you are having problems with spacing between lines, contact Hanna Weinzierl who is part of the Executive Office – info@neuropt.org
- Page Placement
 - If you need to move a page up or down in your navigation bar Sitefinity you can click and drag it to the correct position.
 Movement outside your navigation area contact Online Communications Chair
 - Work with Online Communications Chair for placement of any new pages
 - Inactive or deleted pages if you need to made a page inactive or delete because the old content work with Online Communications Chair to take off navigation
