## Student Corner: Five Tests I Wish I Knew About Earlier in PT Practice



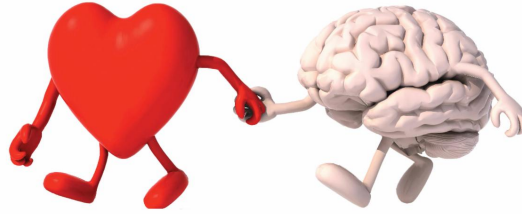

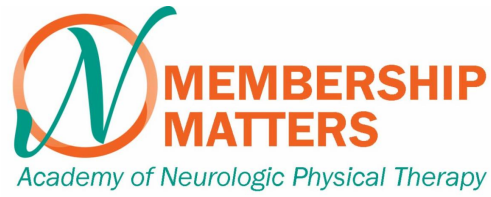
